Attention and Heeling - "ATTENTION" If only it were that easy to be able to say one word to get and keep your dog's attention. This class teaches you how to get and keep your dog's attention, no matter what is going on. If you want to participate in dogsport of any type (Agility, Rally, Obedience etc) or would just like a dog that pays attention, this class is for you. As an added bonus this class will also focus on how to get a really amazing heel, using good body communication and handling skills. Sign up quickly this class is going to be a HIT!

Reactive Dog Modification - Cheryl Smith, internationally recognized canine behaviour specialist will be conducting this class for those dogs that have unique issues interacting with other dogs and or humans. In a safe calm environment you will learn to understand your dog's body language and triggers; and receive advice on how to humanely handle and interrupt explosive behaviour. Learn how to teach desired behaviours to replace inappropriate ones and how to identify arousal which could lead to aggressive behaviour. Limited enrollment in this class.

Working Retriever Class—this class is intended for all Retriever breeds, Irish Water Spaniels and Poodles. All participants should be able to retrieve on command and have a reliable recall. You and your dog will become familiar with Hunt Tests and the Working Certificate Program. You and your dog will have the opportunity to learn how to "mark", how to "line", and how to "sit" on the whistle. Your dog will have fun doing single retrieves on land and perhaps on the water. Your dog will be introduced to birds and (if approved) the sound of a gun (starter pistol). You will be amazed how much the above breeds will enjoy doing what they were bred to do.

Rally Obedience - Two Rally Obedience classes. Beginners/Novice Rally is geared to dogs that has mastered Novice obedience level exercises. The Advanced rally class is more complex and will prepare you and your dog for trial. In Rally, the handlers are encouraged to praise and motivate the dog as they work from station to station within a time limit. Rally puts the fun back in obedience.

TTouch for the Senior Dog—The TTouch method of training can influence your pet's health and behaviour. Senior dogs may experience physiological changes with aging that affect their mobility and comfort. Older dogs who participate in a variety of sports may have an increased incidence of injury and a slower recovery. With the application of TTouch you can improve your pet's mobility, enhance recovery from physical exertion/stress and improve the bond with your pet. TTouch can also help fearful or shy dogs and dogs that pull on the leash, bark, chew, get car sick, have grooming concerns. TTouch can help calm and manage the over-exuberant dog.

The **Fun Games & Tricks** class will teach your dog a dozen or more tricks that will keep him busy and challenged. This is an ideal class for therapy dogs! This easy and gentle level of activity is great for dogs of all ages. Whether you want to volunteer with your dog in hospitals and nursing homes or just want to teach your dog some great tricks just for fun, you must enroll in this class.

Camp Dogwould offers **two levels of Agility**. A basic introduction to the obstacles for the beginner dog, as well as, a more challenging advanced course for those with experience. Agility is a great way to boost your dog's confidence while learning to work on A frames, tunnels, weaves, teeter-totters and more.

NORMA JEANNE LAURETTE

Positive Reinforcement or Positive Punishment

There are as many ways to train a dog as there are dog trainers. Training styles can range from 100% positive reinforcement to 100% positive punishment with a huge range in between, but any tool or technique can be abused. Norma Jeanne will discuss the benefits of positive reinforcement training and the dangers of using aversives. She will also share some of her favourite tools & techniques that can be added to your toolbox.

Dr Alison Seely is a veterinarian certified in animal chiropractic by the American Veterinary Chiropractic Association, and has been practicing animal chiropractic in the Ottawa area for the past 12 years. She has been an invited lecturer at the European Academy of animal Chiropractors and has written numerous articles on the subject. Alternative medicine is very popular because it is non-intrusive and it produces excellent results in reducing discomfort without triggering the side effects so commonly associated with medication. With the mounting concern over commercial dog food many are searching for the right balance and the best diet for their pet. Catherine is a well known consultant for Canine Fitness and Nutrition and she will provide suggestions on how you can improve your pet’s nutrition by providing home cooked diets or by adding supplements to their daily diet.

What to Bring to Camp

- Pack comfortable appropriate clothes for cold, hot and/or rainy weather. All classes are held outdoors - come rain or shine - bring waterproof footwear.
- Pack sheets & blankets (nights can be cool) or sleeping bag & pillow, towels & personal toiletries, sunscreen and bug repellent.
- Camp water is safe for drinking but you may prefer to bring your favourite brand of bottled water and other beverages.
- A notebook, camera, flashlight, assortment of collars and leashes, a lawn chair.
- **Don’t forget to bring a fan for your room!!!** It can get very hot in June.
- Crate for your dog, plastic bags for pick up and your dog’s food and dishes. The campsite is located on the beautiful Rideau River. You and your dog are welcome to swim and splash - so bring a few extra towels to dry Rover dry off.
- Pack the appropriate collar/harness/leash for the training activity you are participating in.
- Working retriever participants bring a flodable bumper if you have one.
- Pack high reward treats and favourite toys.

Canine Accommodations

Your dog can be with you at all times except in the dining hall. For your dog’s safety you must crate your dog when he is left alone. Please bring your own crate. Dog owners not crating their dogs are responsible for any/all damages to camp property. Dogs are not allowed off leash, unless in the training areas and must be supervised. **Please note that handlers allowing their dog to run loose will be asked to leave the camp grounds.** If you leave the camp grounds for an errand and your dog is left in his crate please advise a staff member.

Commuters - bring a crate so you can leave your dog in a cool shaded area during meal time.
